NDDA American Indian Initiative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trying to get a volunteer dentist for Care Mobile to go to the reservations • MOMS will be in Standing Rock in October. They are trying to coordinate everything for the event 	-If needing extra forms, contact Kimberlie Yineman
Update on Grants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HRSA- has been submitted; we should find out if we receive funding by the end of August • CDC- will be submitting May 28, 2013 • DentaQuest- things are going well. Have heard from some clinics that are wanting to implement Smiles For Life, and have received a lot of positive feedback. The hard part is that BCBS will not reimburse 	
Coalition Updates from Other States	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Many other coalitions have hired staff using DentaQuest Grant funds, and some use HRSA grant • Other states have hired coalition staff to help organize and work for the coalition part time, such as an executive director for the coalition 	
Dental Service Corporation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSC will be folding into BCBS • DSC will have funding left over and it has been ongoing debate as to what will be happening to those funds; refunding individuals, put into the dental foundation, etc • The dental foundation met with DSC board and made a pitch that funds should be transferred to the dental foundation. DSC was very perceptive to this idea, but no decisions have been made • They are projecting 4-5 million dollars will be left over
