Legislative and Budget	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submitted in September • General fund makes up 20% of the budget • 170.6 million-total budget for the Health Department • 71% is specific federal grants • 10% is Other funding • Oral Health is all federal funding and is in the budget and built in any other additional federal monies • Loan Repayment programs- not sufficient trust funding to cover all repayments, some of them move into next biennium. • Optional package has dental loan repayments built in as priority #10 • Received a federal grant to possibly use towards loan repayments (non profit) • Dental Practice grants- hardly any interest so this was eliminated and not requested again this biennium but did leave money in to fulfill commitments 	

<p>Committee updates</p>	<p>Policy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dental Loan repayment has been the main discussion • Caremobile is trying to get more funding from legislators • Trying to decide if we need to bring anything forward to the legislators <p>Access</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CareMobile little over 200,000 • 2012 fully booked starting to book 2013 • Things are going very well • Plan to bring forward to legislators to view this session • One challenge has been the computer system • Basin Electric provided a portable van, to carry staff or portable equipment <p>Data</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oral Health Surveillance- Revised summer 2012, and is being published online for easier viewing for states to be able to access easily. It focuses on easily accessible data and bringing in environmental indicators and at-risk areas 	
<p>Medicaid and New Dental Loan Repayment Program</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Received money from federal government and a project is the dental loan repayment • Send out information to non-profit dental clinics • Want them to apply for \$20,000 for a dentist in the first year • The dental clinic actually applies for this and they do not have to have a dentist ready yet • Criteria: must be a new position in the facility, must work at that facility for at least 12 months, they must see a certain number of Medicaid and CHIP patients, and facility can use this as a recruitment tool • Still clarifying things and making sure criteria is correct • Once awarded, data must be received and will make 	

	<p>payment to the dentist</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • December 1st is the deadline to apply • Will award for 1st year, and once received data, could potentially award for the next 2 years, and will cap at \$60,000 • Plan to add a second clinic next year 	
NDDA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dental loan repayment-met with the governor, and are hopeful of receiving funding • 501c3-received application and is in the review phase 	
Elderly Care Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Long Term Care project is going very well • They go 2 days a month to 2 different nursing homes and are hoping to add at least one more facility; have had many requests from other Long Term Care facilities • Have well over 550 patient visits in the facilities • Has been a very rewarding and a good learning experience despite the challenges 	
CDC and HRSA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CDC got \$20,000 more than applied for • Will be reapplying for CDC And HRSA in 2013 	
BSS for the Elderly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Would like to add to the long term care facilities the congregate meal sites • PHH went to 10 facilities and conducted the basic screenings along with a little extra information • Consent was required from patient or guardian • 291 screenings were completed • Will report the results once analyzed 	
American Indians	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dental Oral Health Conference- very good information given, had a large amount of people who wanted to help with this problem • Healthy Steps- creating partnerships and working on oral health prevention • Finalized site visits to all tribal health sites 	
Mission of Mercy MOMS project	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Next October in Standing Rock • Trying to get approval from Reservations 	

Legislative Reception	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2nd week in march • The coalition would like to partner again 	
DentaQuest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Year was needs assessment and set up a plan. This was a very successful year • Applied and have been accepted for years 2 and 3 for implementation • Have gotten great responses and two priority goals are 1) Medical dental collaboration and 2) Prevention and public infrastructure • Had a great diverse task force that did very well • Worked on a short time period strategic plan and also how to maintain after everything has been implemented • Talked through and explained the work plan for year 2 and 3 of this grant • Would like to see the DentaQuest task force members participate and join the Oral Health Coalition
